# EDUCATION CERTIFICATE AT USF SARASOTA-MANATEE

## Wondering what to do with your academic degree?

Now in Florida, those with academic content degrees can be employed as middle- or high-school teachers, with just 6 additional education courses. USFSM has created a new post-baccalaureate certificate that provides the necessary courses.

If your bachelor’s degree is in social science, social studies, history, political science, geography, sociology, economics, psychology, English, biology, chemistry or mathematics, you can be qualified for employment teaching middle or high school in Florida.



### How?

Pursue USFSM’s Post-Baccalaureate **Certificate** in Education, which is completely **online**.

### How does the certificate qualify me to teach in Florida Public Schools?

- With this certificate, or while completing it, you can be hired on a temporary teaching certificate for up to three years.
- While working with the temporary certificate you will supervised and supported as a beginning teacher.
- During this time, you can complete FLDOE requirements for ongoing Professional Certification.
