Invitations were extended to all parents and any interested community members at the beginning of the school year. Those interested in joining SAC were invited to the first meeting.

**Teachers (includes counselors, media specialists, etc.):** SAC Chair met with teachers and principal to identify teachers who were interested in participating on the School Advisory Council. The Principal and SAC Chairperson met to discuss the nominees who were selected by election of their peers at the October SAC Meeting.

**Classified:** The School Principal and the SAC chair queried the classified staff members who might be expressing an interest in serving on the School Advisory Council identified individuals. Classified staff members will respond to School principal if they want to be a representative. Currently an on-going process-Roster will be updated with approved member once voted in.

**Parents:** The School sent home an invitation to suggested parents of all grade levels to join SAC. The ESOL Liaison made contact with all interested Hispanic parents and provided translation. The SAC Chairperson and Principal collaborated to review the nominations. Parents returning from SAC last year made motions and voted for nominees at the first two scheduled SAC meeting in September and October.

**Other Citizen:** Community representation was selected through a process facilitated by Principal, Susan Nations who communicated with the school's business partner coordinator. These nominations were made by returning SAC business and SAC Community members and were voted at the first scheduled SAC meeting in in October.

Wilkinson does not have student participation on SAC at this time.

The School Advisory Council elected a chair who was nominated and voted into office at the first meeting of the school year.
