Scheduling Process

Advanced Placement

- Ⓢ AP Courses are highly regarded by all universities.
 - Ⓢ College credit can be earned based on your AP test score
 - Ⓢ Exams are scored on a scale of 1 – 5
 - Ⓢ You still earn high school credit regardless of your score on the AP Exam
 - Ⓢ To take an AP course you must pass the FSA.
- Ⓢ SPHS senior offerings:
 - Ⓢ AP Psychology
 - Ⓢ AP Environmental Science
 - Ⓢ AP Language and Composition
 - Ⓢ AP English Literature
 - Ⓢ AP Calculus AB
 - Ⓢ AP Calculus BC (only if taken AP Calc AB)

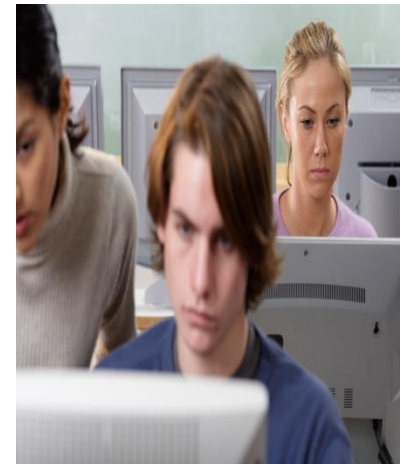
Dual Enrollment

- ④ SCF: Full time or part time offered on SCF campus
 - ④ Part time: 2 Courses per semester at SCF
 - ④ Full time: 4 Courses per semester at SCF
 - ④ 3.0 unweighted GPA Required, 3.5 unweighted GPA recommended
 - ④ Students must pass the PERT or qualify by SAT/ACT scores
- ④ USF/SM – 3.5 unweighted GPA required
- ④ Must provide your own transportation
- ④ This is the start of your college transcript!!
 - ④ Mandatory parent/student meeting with Mrs. Nielubowicz by April 13, 2018
 - ④ May 1st – Deadline for fall registration

(All students will have SPHS/STC schedule until they are officially approved and registered for DE)

SVA or FLVS

- ④ An online option for missing core courses and credit recovery
- ④ Requirements
 - Be able to work with others in completing projects
 - Be able to use the technology properly
 - Be able to meet the minimum standards as set forth by the instructor
 - Be able to complete assignments on time
 - Sign up by **May 1st** if you would like to take a virtual class over the summer.
- ④ FLVS is not an option if class is offered on SVA



Internship

- Students must:
 - Be in 12th Grade
 - Have a 3.0 or above
 - Have good attendance
 - Provide own transportation
 - Earn credit (.5 per a semester)
